





Does It Ever Become Routine?

Do you ever experience complacency in your routine pursuits, be it at home, or work, or elsewhere? If we're not careful, even while ministering at Next Step, we can become complacent in our routine efforts. And yet complacency is not really an option as we are called to "work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men... [we] are serving the Lord Christ (Col. 3:23-24).

have the privilege of preparing and teaching God's Holy Word. We recognize the opportunities we have to explain the Word of God and the manner in which it can be applied to our lives. Yet we know that not all will be doers of His Word, and this can be disappointing, but knowing who we serve, and knowing that His Word does not return void, the work does not become routine. And what about those times when God's Word becomes meaningful to these men, and it becomes the worldview from which these men live? There is great joy and enduring encouragement. We are humbled by the privilege we have to minister to these adopted sons. Praise be to God for the transformational work He is doing and the abundant joy He brings through this work! Because of this, we will always guard against becoming complacent.
